

Attendance - Holidays during term time

Please be reminded that requests submitted for holidays during term time will be subject to Norfolk's Policy for absence. Parents requesting such an absence will only have it authorised under *exceptional* circumstances. This could lead to a fixed penalty

fine being imposed, which equates to £60 per child, per parent; for example, if you take 3 children out of school for more than 5 continuous days within a 12 week period, the potential fine payable would be £120/child x 3 which equates to £360. Department for Education Guidance on attendance.


