- Stalls can be booked at Mundesley infant and junior school office.

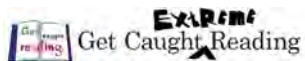

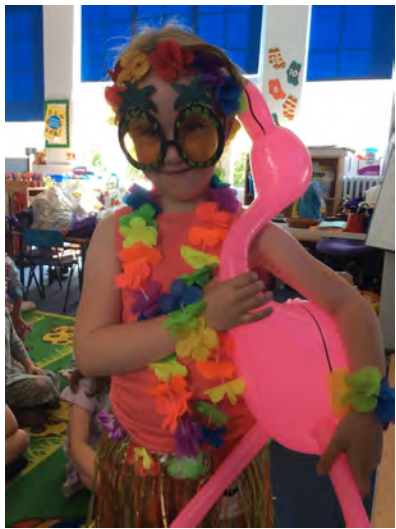


Sparkle Project!

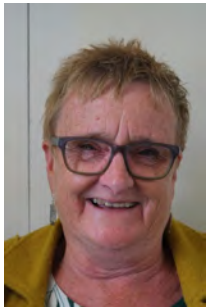
