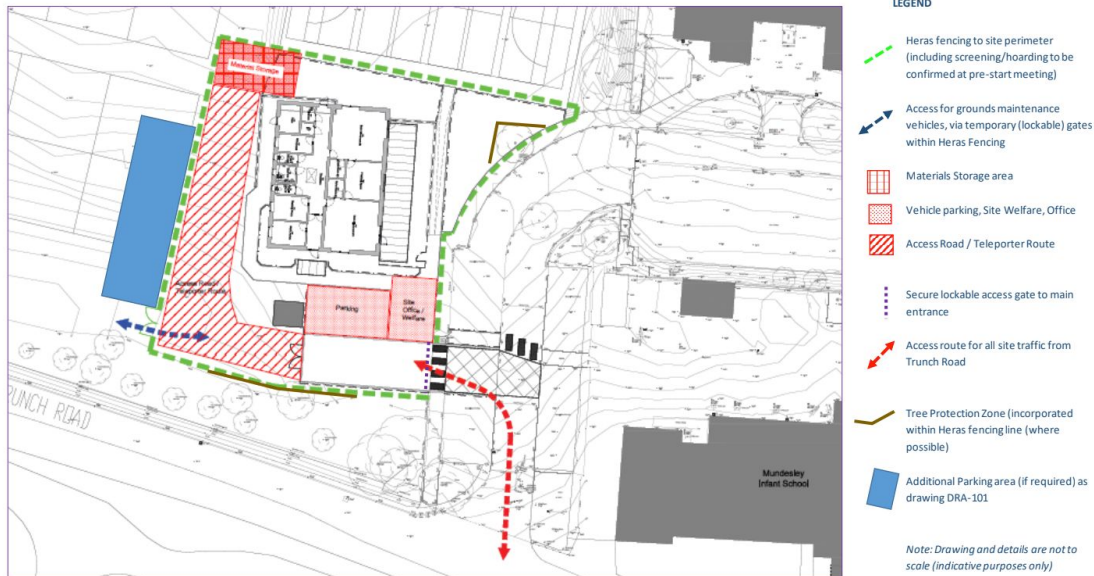
Please bring these into your child's normal school on Monday.

Construction Starting on MIJS Site on Monday 8th March

Not only will all children be starting back on Monday (which we are really excited about) but the construction of the new Special Resource Base (SRB) will commence. Norfolk County Council will be funding this significant project which is due for completion on August 6th.

Obviously safety is a big issue for projects such as this, particularly one that is happening during term time. NCC and Norfolk Property Services, alongside the main contractor, Smiths of Honningham have drawn up extensive planning to ensure that children, parents and staff are kept safe.

The use of the site for children and parents should not alter significantly as their site is completely fenced in. As with all health and safety measures it is important to be vigilant. We will conduct daily visual inspections but if you are on site and see something that you believe is unsafe then please contact Jenny Wood, School Business Manager immediately.
