Visit to Bruce Grove Primary School, London Thursday 25 - Friday 26 May 2023

Some bullet point reminders and tasks before we go;

- Children to arrive no later than 7.25 at Mundesley Junior School - meeting outside of the Junior school building, with bags (parking can be an issue, so please take account of that regarding your arrival time)
- All medication must be put inside a clear plastic bag or sandwich bag with a sticky name label attached to it - this should be handed to Miss Bugg who will be waiting inside for parents ONLY to handover the medication.
- **Please fill in** the following quick [Dietary Requirements and Medication survey](#), make sure we have the most up to date information
- Please make sure that your child has the following items packed;
 - Sleeping bag - IF they possess a roll mat for sleeping on that would be helpful
 - Pillow and pillow case
 - School uniform
 - Waterproof coat and sensible shoes/trainers
 - Clean shirt and change of underwear
 - Nightclothes, toiletries
 - Towel
 - Spending money of no more than £10 - the odd 20p piece might be handy for public toilets
 - Children should **not bring cameras, mobile phones or any other electronic devices.**
