Re: Year 4 residential visit to Hilltop Activity Centre - North Norfolk Wednesday 7th February - Friday 9th February 2024



Dear Parents and Carers,

I am pleased to inform you that as a Federation we have booked our 2024 Year 4 residential visit to Hilltop activity centre on the North Norfolk coast close to Sheringham. We are in the process of confirming final numbers, and thought we would give you one final opportunity to secure a place for your child.

The cost per child is £142.50 or £95 for Pupil Premium children and covers 3 days of adventurous activities and 2 nights. The cost of the visit includes transport to and from Hilltop, meals and all activities led by fully qualified instructors. If you would like your child to take part in the residential visit we request that you pay an initial deposit of **£40** to secure your child's place and a further **£30 by Friday 22nd September**. The balance can then be paid either as a lump sum or in installments by the dates shown below:

Friday 14th July 2023- £40.00 deposit
 Friday 22nd September 2023 - £30.00
 Friday 13th October 2023 - £30.00
 Friday 10th November 2023 - £30.00
 Friday 19th January 2024 - Final payment of £12.50

Please log on to the School Money system to make your payments.

If your child is Pupil Premium your payments will be 5 installments of £19.00.
