Damage to School Equipment at Drop off/Pick up Times

We are writing to inform you about an incident that occurred recently regarding the damage of our school equipment during drop-off and pick-up times.

Yesterday, we were excited to have new play equipment installed in the infant playground, providing additional recreational opportunities for our students. However, this morning, just before school opened, we encountered an unfortunate situation where the newly installed equipment was damaged. It appears that a child was swinging on the item, causing it to be bent out of shape.

Please be reminded that all children arriving in school **should not use any items of play equipment.** This incident not only affects the immediate availability of the equipment for all children but also poses safety risks. Please help us to provide safe equipment for your children to play on in school by not allowing them to play before coming into the school.

The drop off window in the mornings is designed to provide a quick and efficient way for parents to arrive and walk through the site dropping their children off safely and not having to wait/congregate, this provides a smooth transition into the day for the children.
